Real stories from people we have blessed through this program

I am a single father of three I am currently in need of gifts for my children I am currently unemployed these past few years for me and my children have been homeless living with family members in there our current situation around this time we were in the shelter I have just gotten a place this July my current income is from welfare this will be our first Christmas in our own home as a family together their mother is no longer with us she passed away May 2015 and it just have been hard for us ever since I want really appreciate the opportunity for my kids to enjoy their Christmas thank you and enjoy your day

Domestic violence victim. I suffer from ptsd and social anxiety. I've had a very difficult year. I have no income.

I work part time and at the moment i am the only one whose providing since their father isn't able to help out because of medical reasons. I am the only one in the house hold who is paying for all the bills and necessities for the home. There are times i have to pick and choose what bill i am able to pay when i get paid. I have to pay for laundry and there are times that i can't do laundry for my kids and myself because i can't afford it. I would really like to be considered for the program as i would love the kids have a good Christmas.

At the moment my husband only working 2-3 days a week. im disabled and our house is failing apart.our mortgage is on a hardship program untill the end of the year.we are struggling to catch up with 3 kids.im blind ,my husband is dyslexic, my older son has adhd and asthma,my other son has dyslexic and add,and my daughter has Kawasaki disease

im legally blind I receive social security my husband works 2-3 days a week we struggled everyday to pay the bills and put food on the table our house needs to be rebulid and we cant afford it

Well I was in a car accident on October 30th broke my ankle I have three children at home and I can't work so there's no money coming in to help with rent bills or a Christmas for my kids I scraped together the last little bit of money I had to get them a Christmas tree I mean it's been hard I'm trying my hardest thing get back on my feet but I'm still in a cast and I can't work I'm struggling and I don't know what to do I'd appreciate it any help that you could help with my kids are 13 12 and 10 two boys and a girl

Being a full time student with a child in preschool has been a challenge. I travel five days a week to Stockton university which has caused me to spend a substantial amount of money on gas on top of household bills all with a once a month SSI check. Any assistance to my household would be a great blessing to our home.

My family is facing personal & Financial hardships after leaving an abusive relationship. We have no vehicle and are at risk of losing our home. I have no help with my 1 year old son. His father collects child tax credit for him but refuses to provide any kind of support. I'm struggling to pay my rent, bills & buy diapers. I won't be able to give my kids the Christmas they deserve this year.
