HOW TO REGISTER:

- **1.** Download your YMCA Summer Camp packet from the Y's website (depending on the age of your child, or your location) and fill it out completely (https://www.vinelandymca.org/camps/general-information.php)
- 2. Obtain your child's immunization record from your Primary Care Physician
- **3.** Visit the YMCA Member Service Desk and register for a YMCA Membership
- **4.** Then visit the Childcare Annex (located next door to the Y) to register for your child's camp*; to register, parent must pay a \$20.00 deposit for all weeks of camp they wish to secure (deposit is deducted from the weekly total)

AGES 3 TO 5 YEARS OLD | HELD AT THE YMCA

Cost: \$209.50 per week except for week 3 – \$167.60

Day includes a healthy breakfast and lunch, activities including outside time, crafts, games and music, naptime, safe swim instruction, and water play!

1	June 17 - June 21	Movin' and Groovin' This week, our young musicians will dance to the beat of their own drum! Through the creation of their own instruments, dancing, and more, campers will grow their love and appreciation for music and influential musicians through the years.
2	June 24 – June 28	Fantastical Fairytales and Storybook Characters Once upon a time And happily, ever after! This week will bring beanstalks, fire-breathing dragons, trolls, fairies, and even an elf or two, a uniquely real and playful week is in store for all campers. Bring your imagination for a fantastic week of fun.

Cost: \$210 per week except for week 3 – \$168

Transportation is provided from the Y Facility in Vineland wot YMCA Camp Merrywood, located in Pittsgrove Township (about 15 minutes away). Day includes a healthy breakfast and lunch, access to our beautiful 68-acre campground with mini golf, Gaga, Spikeball, nature grails, Crossnet, archery, low ropes course, mountain bikes, and zip line!

Merrywood campers will enjoy time swimming in Lake Greenbranch, including swim instruction; campers also have options for kayaking, canoeing, or corcling!



THE SUMMER LEARNING LOSS PREVENTION (SLLP) CAMP

The Y's Summer Learning Loss Prevention program focuses on engaging students over the course of the summer through educational programming. Students who consistently attended SLLP gained up to three months in reading – thus reducing summer learning loss.

Our program is structured to prevent summer learning loss with the Four Block Curriculum, which is a balanced literacy framework for teaching language arts. This program integrates four language arts areas into reading instruction. These areas are: guided reading, self-selected reading, writing, and working with words.

WHY AN ACA-ACCREDITED CAMP?



ANSWERS TO PARENTS' MOST FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the difference between state licensing of camps and accreditation by the ACA?

Accreditation is voluntary and ACA accreditation assures families that camps have made the commitment to safe, nurturing environment for their children. If a state requires licensing, it is mandatory; licensing requirements vary from state to state. ACA standards are recognized by courts of law and government regulators as the standards of the camp community.

How do ACA standards exceed state licensing requirements?

ACA goes beyond basic requirements for health, cleanliness, and food service into specific areas of programming, including camp staff from director through counselors, emergency management plans, health care, and management. ACA applies separate standards for activities.

OTHER CHILD CARE AT THE Y

PRESCHOOL PROGRAM

The Cumberland Cape Atlantic YMCA, in partnership with the Vineland School district, offers a FREE preschool educational program to 3 and 4-year-old Vineland residents. This program provides six hours (9:30am to 3:30pm) of developmentally appropriate curriculum. Registration for this program is through the Vineland School District Registration Office. A NAEYC (National Association of the Education of Young Children accredited program.

BEFORE AND AFTERCARE PROGRAM

Our Y's Before and After School program extends your child's learning day in a fun and meaningful way! Our program focuses on character development and healthy living, children experience academic, physical, and social activities, under the supervision of positive, caring role models. Parents enjoy peace of mind knowing their school-age children have safe, healthy options before and after school.



When school is closed Holiday Care is available at the Y for an additional fee. Holiday Care participants will be offered a variety of planned and age-appropriate activities such as sports, health and fitness, group games, reading, art activities, and swimming. Holiday Care requires all participants to have a minimum of a YMCA Program Membership, must pre-register, and make payment prior to the day of care.

CHILD WATCH WHILE YOU WORKOUT

Workout, take a class, or go for a swim, while your little one is cared for in a safe, nurturing environment. The CCAYMCA offers low-cost, convenient drop-in child watch for children 6 months to 10 years old. Child Watch is a drop-off service our Members may utilize while they work out or take a class in our facility. Your child will be provided with a positive experience in a secure, happy environment. Parents must remain on the premises at all times. Fees are \$4 per hour per child for Facility Members, and \$5 per hour per child for Program Members.
