HOW TO REGISTER:

- **1.** Download your YMCA Summer Camp packet from the Y's website (depending on the age of your child, or your location) and fill it out completely (https://www.vinelandymca.org/camps/general-information.php)
- 2. Obtain your child's immunization record from your Primary Care Physician
- **3.** Visit the Childcare Annex (located next door to the Y) to register for your child's camp. A \$20 deposit per week is required at registration to secure your child's spot. The deposit will be deducted from the weekly total. This deposit is non-refundable. A One-time 2025 camp registration fee of \$50 is due at registration.

ANSWERS TO PARENTS' MOST FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:



What is the difference between state licensing of camps and accreditation by the ACA?

Accreditation is voluntary and ACA accreditation assures families that camps have made the commitment to safe, nurturing environment for their children. If a state requires licensing, it is mandatory; licensing requirements vary from state to state. ACA standards are recognized by courts of law and government regulators as the standards of the camp community.

How do ACA standards exceed state licensing requirements?

ACA goes beyond basic requirements for health, cleanliness, and food service into specific areas of programming, including camp staff from director through counselors, emergency management plans, health care, and management. ACA applies separate standards for activities.

Praesidium then verified the YMCA's successful implementation of these standards. The Cumberland Cape Atlantic YMCA will be accredited for three years, and during this time will commit to uphold fundamental organizational values and stringent safety practices that demonstrate their commitment to protecting those in their care from abuse.

PRESCHOOL PROGRAM

The Cumberland Cape Atlantic YMCA, in partnership with the Vineland School district, offers a FREE preschool educational program to 3 and 4 year old Vineland residents. This program provides six hours (8:10am to 2:10pm) of developmentally appropriate curriculum. Registration for this program is through the Vineland School District Registration Office. A NAEYC (National Association of the Education of Young Children) accredited program.

BEFORE AND AFTERCARE PROGRAM

Our Y's Before and After School program extends your child's learning day in a fun and meaningful way! Our program focuses on character development and healthy living. Children experience academic, physical, and social activities, under the supervision of positive, caring role models. Parents enjoy peace of mind knowing their school-age children have safe, healthy options before and after school.

HOLIDAY CARE

When school is closed Holiday Care is available at the Y for an additional fee. Holiday Care participants will be offered a variety of planned and age-appropriate activities such as sports, health and fitness, group games, reading, art activities, and swimming. Holiday Care requires all participants to have a minimum of a YMCA Program Membership, must pre-register, and make payment prior to the day of care.

CHILD WATCH WHILE YOU WORKOUT

Workout, take a class, or go for a swim, while your little one is cared for in a safe, nurturing environment. The CCAYMCA offers convenient drop-in child watch for children 6 months to 10 years old. Child watch is a drop-off service for our members while they work out or take a class in our facility. Your child will be provided with a positive experience in a secure, happy environment. Parents must remain on the premises at all times.
